Talbot (Sandy) D'Alemberte may be best known to the Tallahassee community as the President Emeritus of the Florida State University, having served as President from 1994 to 2003. However, many attendees at the upcoming ALA Managing Partner Forum and Luncheon will remember him best as the Dean of the FSU College of Law from 1984 to 1989. Earlier he represented Dade County in the Florida House of Representatives from 1966 to 1972.
